Personal

Being based in nearby Chipping Sodbury for many years makes Badminton a local show for former Beaufort Pony Club member Nick Gauntlett. Nick has been a professional rider since he left school and has recently extended his yard to accommodate 30 boxes and its' own gallops.

Rocket Science was acquired from breeder and dealer Donal Barnwell as a three-year-old while Woodside Alcatraz was bought locally from Julia Zorab in 2007. Nick acquired the ride on the mare Chapel Amble last year from owner/rider Sally Arcsott a previous competitor at Badminton in 1998. Chapel Amble is German bred by the Thoroughbred Amerigo Vespucci the same sire as German team horse Air Jordan.

Nick who trains with Badminton dressage commentator Pammy Hutton in nearby Cirencester has enjoyed a recent run of success with his horses in pure dressage. He also has the ride on Chris and Lisa Stone's SHB (GB) approved breeding and competition stallion Chilli Morning with who he is on the BE equine pathway for 2012. The combination will be part of the Badminton stallion parade held on Saturday.
